New Bushfire Controls – Warrnambool Planning Scheme

The bushfire hazard mapping has been reviewed and updated by the Department of Environment, Land, Water & Planning in conjunction with the Country Fire Authority. This update forms part of the Victorian Government's commitment to implement all of the recommendations of the 2009 Victorian Bushfires Royal Commission.

The Minister for Planning has recently approved revised Bushfire Management Overlay (BMO) mapping into a number of Planning Scheme's across the State of Victoria. In Warrnambool, a number of publically and privately owned properties are affected.
