We love our dogs, not what they leave behind.



One pile of dog poo can take **1 year or more** to fully breakdown

There are currently about **3,500 dogs** registered in Warrnambool



Dog poo is a common carrier of:

- ▲ Heartworms
- ▲ Whipworms
- ▲ Hookworms
- ▲ Roundworms
- ▲ Tapeworms
- ▲ Parvovirus
- ▲ Giardia
- ▲ Salmonella
- ▲ E. coli



You risk a **\$311 fine** for not picking up after your dog

How can you help?

Be prepared

1. Take a bag with you
2. Tie it to your dogs lead
3. Reuse your old plastic bags
4. Scoop the poop everytime!



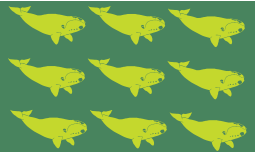
No one wants dog poo in the space they walk
