### About the program

Immunisation clinics are conducted by appointment every Thursday at the Childrens Services Centre, corner of Kepler Street & Raglan Pde, Warrnambool. In addition, after hours clinics are held once a month on a Tuesday evening and Saturday morning.

Please call Council's Immunisation Program on 5559 4855 to arrange an appointment time.

All vaccinations are conducted by highly trained and experienced immunisation nurses in a child friendly environment.

Please bring your child's Health Record book and Medicare card to all appointments. Following vaccination, a 15 minute observation period is required.

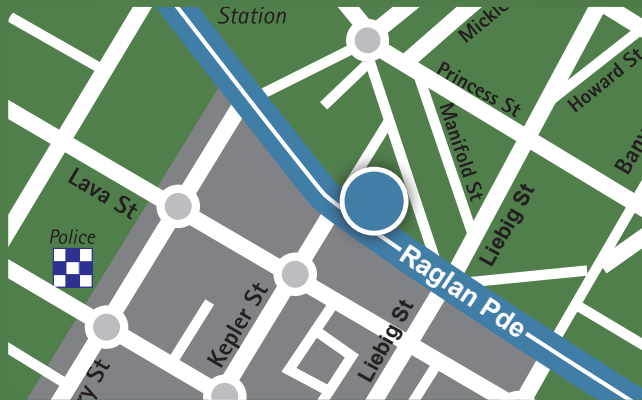
