CLUB & USER GROUP ENGAGEMENT

Inside Edge Sport and Leisure Planning recently delivered a series of workshops between 24th and 26th of March 2025 to understand the needs and priorities of clubs and user groups.

51 attendees representing 34 clubs and user groups attended the workshops held at the Lighthouse Theatre.

Clubs and user groups have also completed an online survey regarding participation and project priorities, with 49 survey responses received.

The engagement of clubs and user groups has identified a range of needs relating to facilities, volunteer support, administration and planning for consideration in the update of the Active Warrnambool Strategy.



NEXT STEPS

Following the completion of our engagement with clubs, user groups and community, Inside Edge Sport and Leisure Planning will commence the development of the Draft Active Warrnambool Strategy.

Council will provide an opportunity for community input on the Draft Active Warrnambool Strategy via a public exhibition process, with club representatives and community stakeholders to be invited to provide feedback.
