

Construction Update

Wollaston Road Upgrade Project

December 2024

Welcome to the second construction update for the Wollaston Road Upgrade Project!

This update outlines what to expect leading up to Christmas.

Works snapshot: November & December

Works will continue between Sommerville Boulevard and Merri River School, with minimal disruption to traffic on Wollaston Road.

At the Caramut Road end of the project, the footpath between Yarra Drive and Roaches Road will be finished this year, and earthworks for the road upgrade will begin in mid-December.

Construction Hours

Normal construction hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.

Prior notification will be provided if works are required to take place out of normal construction hours.

Upcoming works - Caramut Road to Roaches Road

Footpath works

Between Yarra Drive and Roaches Road

November / December 2024


 A 1.5m wide concrete footpath will be built between Yarra Drive and Roaches Road. The footpath will be located on the south side of Wollaston Road only, and positioned along the edge of the road reserve.

Contract details

Caramut Road to Roaches Road

This stage of the project is being delivered by Harrington Property Group as part of their Riverland Estate development obligations.

The works will be carried out by Duggan Civil Pty Ltd, the appointed contractor for this stage.





Earthworks

Between Yarra Drive and Roaches Road December 2024

- The new road surface will be lower than the existing – up to 1 metre lower in some areas. To achieve this, nearly three Olympic-sized swimming pools of soil will need to be removed from this section of the project before placing the crushed rock for the new road pavement.
- The excavation will be done in sections, working on one half of the road at a time.
- During normal construction hours, one lane of Wollaston Road will be temporarily closed, with traffic diverted to the other lane. Traffic lights will control the flow of vehicles, and minor delays are expected.
- Outside of normal construction hours, both lanes of Wollaston Road will reopen to traffic, but a reduced speed limit will be in place.

Upcoming works – Sommerville Boulevard to Merri River School



Stormwater drainage works Sommerville Boulevard to Merri River School

November / December 2024

- Stormwater drainage installation will continue through to Christmas. This essential work will enhance the area's drainage capacity and support the overall road upgrade.
- No impact to traffic is expected at this stage, as the works will take place away from the existing traffic lanes.

Road pavement works

Sommerville Boulevard to Merri River School

December 2024

- Pavement construction will begin in December on the new eastbound traffic, bike and parking lanes.
- The new road pavement will be 490mm deep and built with layers of Class 4, Class 3 and Class 2 crushed rock, topped with an asphalt surface.
- The existing eastbound lane of Wollaston Road will be temporarily closed at times, with all traffic redirected to the westbound lane. Traffic lights will manage the flow of vehicles, and minor delays are expected.

Contract details

Sommerville Boulevard to Merri River School

This stage of the project is being delivered by Rodger Constructions Pty Ltd as part of their Wollaston Way Estate development obligations.

They will carry out the works themselves.





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
