Allansford Flood Investigation Mapping – Presentation and Community Meeting

The investigation of riverine and stormwater flooding for Allansford is a collaborative project between Council and the Glenelg Hopkins Catchment Management Authority with consultants Water Technology engaged to provide specialist expertise and advice.

Phone Survey – Running Until March 2025

Until mid-March, residents may receive a call from National Field Services as part of the Community Satisfaction Survey. This survey is held annually, with most Victorian councils taking part.
