The Asset Plan rests on the processes outlined within Council's Asset Management Policy, Asset Management Strategy, Asset Management Plans and its integration with Council's Long Term Financial Plan as part of the Integrated Strategic Planning and Reporting process. This plan improves the transparency around asset value and performance, the type of assets under council management and their financial impost and also articulates and communicates the challenges on service levels, costs, risks, and the considerations for the decisions made.

At the Council meeting on 6 June 2022, the Asset Plan 2022-2032 was approved for release in draft form for public comment.
