Pet registrations need to be paid by April 10 each year.

If you no longer own your pet, if it has passed away or if you have moved house please contact us on 5559 4800 so we can update our records. If you still have your pet, but you haven't paid its annual registration, please do so now to avoid additional costs.

If your cat or dog goes missing or wanders away from home, you have a much better chance of them being returned home if they are registered.

Registering your animal with Council also helps cover the cost of running Council's animal shelter and the restocking of numerous dog bag dispensers in popular dog-walking locations.
