#### Warrnambool Urban Forest Plan

# The Warrnambool City Council is in the process of developing an Urban Forest Plan.

The term urban forest refers to the collection of trees and other vegetation within urban areas, including parks, streets, front yards and backyards. It's not just about individual trees but rather the interconnected ecosystem they create in our cities and towns.

A healthy urban forest can provide a multitude of ecosystem benefits, including air filtration, carbon sequestration, and soil stabilisation. Additionally, trees offer shade, which reduces energy consumption for cooling, and they contribute to biodiversity by providing habitats for fauna. Importantly, their presence in urban areas promotes mental well-being and community cohesion while also adding aesthetic value to the surroundings.
