### Warrnambool Fox Baiting Program

A fox baiting program will be undertaken on Council managed land to assist in protecting native wildlife, including threatened species from foxes. Bait will be buried to reduce the risk of non-target poisoning. Warning signs will be displayed to notify the public of the program.

Foxecute, PAPP (para-aminopropiophenone) poison can be lethal to dogs and cats. Dogs, cats and other pets must not enter the baited Council managed land west of the Warrnambool Sewage Treatment Plant, areas of Lake Pertobe, Pickering Point and behind the Skate Park.

**Bait will be laid between TUESDAY 26 SEPTEMBER & TUESDAY 24 OCTOBER 2023. The baited areas will be closed to dogs and other pets (including dogs on leads), during and up to 4 weeks after the fox baiting program.**

Immediate vet assessment is required for any pet suspected of PAPP poisoning. The following vets are stockists of the antidote:
