### Warrnambool Foreshore Framework Plan Community Engagement Workshop

Council, in conjunction with REALM studios are developing the Warrnambool Foreshore Framework Plan.

The project aims to create a shared vision and strategic plan to guide the future of the Warrnambool foreshore precinct over the next 20 years. The plan will consider strategic social, economic and environmental values of the precinct.

The plan covers the foreshore to the south of Warrnambool's Central Business district, bordering the Lady Bay and southern ocean. It sits between the outlet of the Merri River at Stingray Bay to the west, and the Flume access point off Merri Street to the east. It is bordered by Pertobe Road to the north.

As part of the planning process, REALM studios will lead a face-to-face community workshop, which will provide an opportunity for residents and community members to learn about the project, discuss their aspirations and concerns for the foreshore, and share their vision for the future of this important place.

**The community workshop will take place at 5.30pm, Thursday 30 November, at the Council Reception Room (Level 1 – 25 Liebig Street, Warrnambool, external entry via the courtyard).**
