Council is inviting the community to provide feedback

on Council's Principal Pedestrian Network (PPN) as a strategic network of pedestrian routes that will be guided by the Sustainable Transport Strategy 2010-2020 (STS) objectives to strengthen the pedestrian network across the city. PPN supports Council's vision to provide high quality, safe and accessible pedestrian facilities across the municipality. It will be used by Council to prioritise its future investigations and infrastructure upgrades to those links that are key connections across the municipality and have the potential to connect a higher number of people to key destinations.

At the Council meeting on 22 November 2021, the Principal Pedestrian Network (PPN) was approved by Council to be released in draft form for public comment.
