### Expressions of Interest - Run in the 2024 Changchun Marathon

Expressions of interest are currently being sought from Warrnambool City Council residents to take part in the 2024 Changchun Marathon in China on 1 September. As a sister city of Warrnambool, Changchun has extended an invitation for up to four Warrnambool representatives to take part.

The competition is for long distance runners or amateur athletes to compete in the full marathon (42.2km), half marathon (21.1km) or 6.8km race.

The organising committee of the Changchun Marathon will cover food, accommodation and travel expenses within Changchun, including airport transfers for a duration of 2 nights.

Applicants are responsible for arranging their own airfares and travel insurance. Any expenses incurred from choosing to stay for longer than 2 nights, or visiting areas outside of the city of Changchun are the responsibility of the applicant.

## Works & Road Closures

### Pecten Avenue Reserve (12-16 Pecten Avenue, Warrnambool)

## CBD Footpath Renewal Works

- **South side of Lava Street between Liebig St and Fairy St**
- **East and West sides of Kepler St between Raglan Pde and Lava St**

**Commencement Date:** Monday 5 August 2024

**Impact:** Footpath fencing and pedestrian detours will be in place. Road speed reductions will be in place and minor delays may be experienced while traffic is held to get trucks in and out of the site. Access to businesses will still be available for the majority of the works.

## Vegetation clearing in vicinity of Power Line Conductors
