### South Warrnambool Flood Investigation

**Warrnambool City Council in conjunction with the Glenelg Hopkins Catchment Management Authority (GHCMA) will undertake a flood investigation of riverine and storm tide (oceanic) flooding for the South Warrnambool catchment area.**

A flood investigation is a comprehensive investigation of flood behaviour within a catchment. It provides detailed information about the nature of flood risk including the distribution, extent, depths, levels and velocity of floodwaters for a range of storm events.

Feedback is needed from landowners, residents, and businesses to help draw on local knowledge regarding past flood events in South Warrnambool. These insights are pivotal. Feedback can be provided by completing an online survey.
