Phone survey will run from January 29 until mid-March

From January 29 through until mid-March, residents may receive a call from National Field Services as part of the Community Satisfaction Survey.

This survey is held annually, with most Victorian Councils taking part.

Participants will be asked to share their views on the Warrnambool City Council's performance across a range of key areas.

- They will always identify themselves as National Field Services and tell you their name
- They will always say how long the survey is expected to take
- The call will come from a landline with a (03) 9977 prefix – never from a mobile.
