### Proposed Road Discontinuances

#### Hider Street Warrnambool (Timor Street – Koroit Street)

Warrnambool City Council, acting under Section 12 of the Road Management Act 2004, proposes to discontinue two sections of road on Hider Street, Warrnambool, between Koroit Street and Timor Street. Upon discontinuance, the subject land, currently a Government road, will revert to unreserved Crown Land.

### Pecten Avenue Reserve (12-16 Pecten Avenue, Warrnambool)

**Works:** Construction of the West Warrnambool Neighbourhood House.
