#### Objectives of the proposed Local Law

The objective of the proposed Local Law is to revoke Council's Local Law Number 2 – Short Stay Accommodation Local Law.

#### Intended effect of the proposed Local Law

The intended effect of the proposed Local Law is to revoke Council's Local Law Number 2 – Short Stay Accommodation Local Law immediately upon Council making the proposed Local Law.
