South Warrnambool Flood Investigation – The Next Stage

The South Warrnambool community is invited to provide suggestions for flood mitigation solutions for South Warrnambool.

The various flood mitigation options will then be discussed at a meeting to be held at the **Merrivale Cricket Club on Wednesday 8 November from 5pm***.

To ensure suggestions are considered at the 8 November meeting, Council requires submissions to be received by 5pm, Friday 27 October.

The 8 November meeting will focus on selecting two flood mitigation options for high-level, pre-feasibility cost-benefit assessment, including modelling of the likely on-ground outcomes of the selected options.

The investigation of riverine and storm tide (oceanic) flooding for South Warrnambool is a joint project between Council and the Glenelg Hopkins Catchment Management Authority with consultants Venant Solutions engaged to provide specialist expertise and advice.
