Draft Budget 2022 – 2023 & Council Plan 2021 – 2025

Council has released its draft Budget 2022-2023 and draft Council Plan 2021-2025 for public exhibition and comment.

In accordance with Sections 94 and 90 of the Local Government Act (2020) Warrnambool City Council:

1. Has prepared its Budget for the financial year commencing 1 July 2022 and ending 30 June 2023 and developed a four-year Council Plan.
2. Made available copies of the proposed Budget and Council Plan 2021-2025 for inspection online at www.yoursaywarrnambool.com.au and in hard copy at the Warrnambool Civic Centre, 25 Liebig Street, Warrnambool.
3. Is accepting feedback from the community in relation both the draft Budget and draft Council Plan in accordance with Section 55 of the Local Government Act (2020). Anyone proposing to make a written submission on a proposal contained in the Budget and/or Council Plan 2021-2025 must do so before 5pm, Wednesday 1 June 2022. Written submissions must be addressed to the Chief Executive, Warrnambool City Council, 25 Liebig Street, Warrnambool 3280 or made online at www.yoursaywarrnambool.com.au
4. Intends to, having taken into account any submissions, adopt the draft Budget and draft Council Plan 2021-2025 at an Additional Council Meeting to be held at 5.45pm, Monday 27 June 2022 at the Lighthouse Theatre Studio, 185 Timor Street, Warrnambool.

Those making a submission are invited to speak in support of their submission for up to five minutes at a Hearings Council Meeting to be held at 5.45pm, Monday 6 June 2022 at the Lighthouse Theatre Studio, 185 Timor Street, Warrnambool.

Those wishing to be heard in support of their written submission must clearly request this in their submission. A respondent will be entitled to appear in person or by a person acting on their behalf.
