### Allansford Flood Investigation Mapping – Presentation & Community Meeting

The investigation of riverine and stormwater flooding for Allansford is a collaborative project between Council and the Glenelg Hopkins Catchment Management Authority with consultants Water Technology engaged to provide specialist expertise and advice.
