Are you interested in cycling with others on Warrnambool's wonderful paths and trails but haven't ridden for a long time... or have you never learnt to ride? Then an AustCycle course might be just the thing for you.



**AustCycle Level 1:** 10-11.30am on Mondays & Tuesdays. Suited to people wanting to learn to ride or those who have not ridden for a long time. Bikes and trikes are available for use in the courses or you can bring your own.

**AustCycle Level 2:** 10-11.30am or 1-2.30pm on Fridays. Suited to people who want to learn to ride on roads in low traffic environments e.g. short trips around town, to commute or to get from home to ride with the social cyclists rides.
