Declaration of Boating Activity Exemption

I, Glenn Reddick, Manager Infrastructure Services, at Warrnambool City Council, Waterway Manager for the Hopkins River, declare under section 203(3) of the Marine Safety Act 2010 (Vic) that the Australian Whale Boat Racing Championship event, is exempt from Regulation 96(6) and 100(3) of the Marine Safety Regulations 2012, in respect to the requirements to carry a PFD for each person on board and wear a PFD.

This declaration applies to persons and vessel competing in the Australian Whale Boat Championship from 9am to 5pm on 16 February 2014 on the waters of the Hopkins River between the bridge and an imaginary line extending from the centreline of Bostock Street, provided the stated safety controls and undertakings detailed in the Event Application and Safety Management Plan are adhered to.

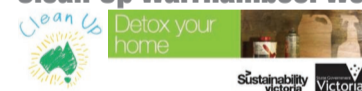
