Works & Road Closures

Dales Road

Works: Drainage works and roundabout construction at intersection with Gateway Road.

Duration: Works completed by end November 2014.

Impact: Parts of the roadway may be closed to traffic, expect some delays.

Foreshore Promenade

Works: Sand removal with heavy plant being used.

Duration: 1 week.

Impact: Promenade closed to pedestrian traffic from Surf Club to Flume access.

Mortlake Road

(north of Moore Street roundabout)

Works: Installation of additional culverts underneath the road and alterations to footpath.

Duration: 2-3 weeks.

Impact: Road will be open to traffic under speed restriction and traffic control. Footpath under Mortlake Road will reopened towards the end of July, subject to weather conditions. Traffic controllers will assist school children in crossing Mortlake Road at the Breton Street intersection until the footpath is open for use.

Pickering Point

Works: Stairs upgrade.

Duration: 3 weeks.

Impact: Stairway will be closed.

Raglan Parade

(between Laverock Road & Hopetoun Road)

Works: Medium strip work.

Duration: 1 week.

Impact: Temporary lane closures. Please observe signage.

Stephen Street Footbridge

Works: Bridge works.

Duration: 3 weeks.

Impact: Pedestrians to observe all signage.

Swan Reserve Play Space Stage 2

(Raglan Parade)

Works: Upgrade the existing Swan Reserve play space adjacent to the kindergarten.

Duration: Works completed by end November 2014.

Impact: Minimal disruption to pedestrian movement.

Timor Street, No. 153

Works: Bus stop installation.

Duration: 3 weeks.

Impact: Parts of the roadway may be closed.

New Flood Controls

Warrnambool Planning Scheme Amendment C78

Amendment C78 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme is currently on public exhibition. The amendment applies to land within the Merri River and Russells Creek floodplains as identified as being liable to flooding and inundation during a severe storm of 1 in 100 year intensity.

The amendment proposes to implement the recommendations of the *North Warrnambool Flood Study (2010)*, the *South Warrnambool Flood Study (2007)* and the *Dennington Flood Study (2007)*. Great South Coast Street Smart Lighting Project Stage 1 of Warrnambool City Councils street lighting installations as part of the Great South Coast Street Lighting Project have commenced.

Councils 2,200 residential mercury vapour streetlights will be replaced with new energy efficient LED lights. These new lights will cut energy usage by 77% compared to the existing 80 watt mercury vapour lamps and will considerably reduce running costs. The first stage involves 1068 lights being upgraded to LED fittings and is planned to be completed by 18 July. Visit Council's website for further information.
