## Works & Road Closures

### 76 Fairy Street

(Construction of Off Street Car Park)

**Works:** Pavement and sealing works.

**Duration:** 2 weeks.

**Impact:** Parts of the roadway may be closed.

### Lake Pertobe Maze

**Works:** Maintenance works.

**Duration:** 1 week.

**Impact:** The maze will be closed.

### Stanley Street Bridge

**Works:** Handrail improvements.

**Duration:** 3 weeks.

**Impact:** Parts of the roadway may be closed.

### Koroit Street Public Toilets

**Works:** Koroit Street public toilet upgrade.

**Duration:** 6 weeks.

**Impact:** A small section of footpath will be cordoned off but will remain open for pedestrian traffic. While the upgrade is taking place, toilets are available in the nearby Target complex or in the Coles carpark.

### Moore Street

**Works:** Footpath construction.

**Duration:** 1 week.

**Impact:** Minor impact to traffic conditions.

### Mortlake Road

(north of Moore Street roundabout)

**Works:** Installation of additional culverts underneath the road and alterations to footpath.

**Duration:** 4 weeks.

**Impact:** Road will be open to traffic under speed restriction and traffic control. Footpath under Mortlake Road will be closed from 17 March – 30 May. Traffic controllers will assist school children in crossing Mortlake Road at the Breton Street intersection until the footpath is open for use.

### Liebig Street Traffic Closure: 20 May 2014

Liebig Street between Koroit and Timor Street will be closed from 6am – 6pm. No parking and through traffic will be permitted in this area however pedestrians will still be permitted.

As part the Traffic Management Plan **free parking** is being provided in Crammond and Dickson, Ozone and Art Gallery off-street car park areas.

Some crew trucks and cars will be parked in the Crammond Street. These areas will be marked.

### Corner Merri & Kelp Street: 21 May 2014, 11am – 3pm

Filming will take place on this corner in front of Flagstaff Hill Maritime Village. Traffic managers will be in place.

### Viaduct Road & Thunder Point Areas: 22 – 31 May 2014

Subject to weather conditions, Oddball Productions will be filming in various locations in this area. Please watch for pedestrians and crew vehicles. Some disruption to traffic and walking tracks is expected. Signage will be in place.
