Run A Half Marathon - In China!

Changchun China International Sister Cities Half-Marathon Invitational Race

Expressions of interest are sought for up to two Warrnambool residents to compete on behalf of Warrnambool City at the Third China Changchun International Sister Cities Half-Marathon Invitational Race to be held on Saturday 13 September 2014. The competition is for long distance runners or amateur athletes to compete in the half marathon (21.0975km) or mini marathon (3.8km). Professional marathon athletes or professionals who have been retired for less than 2 years are not permitted to enter the competition. Half marathon participants should be aged between 16 to 65, with mini marathon participants aged above 12 years. The course for the event is the ring road through the Jingyue National Forest Park, Changchun.

The City of Changchun will cover transportation, food and accommodation during the athletes stay in Changchun. Warrnambool City Council will contribute up to \$500 towards airfares. Participants would be expected to arrange their own insurance, visas and any potential travel outside of the visit to Changchun. The expected duration of the stay in Changchun is 4 days.
