Warrnambool Planning Scheme

Notice of Approval of Amendment: Amendment C75

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C75 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme. The Amendment came into operation on 13 February 2014, as published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment facilitates the residential development of the Coastal Hopkins River Environmental Structure Plan area (south of Hopkins Point Road) by rezoning land to the Neighbourhood Residential Zone, Rural Living Zone and Public Conservation and Resource Zone, introducing a new Schedule 17 to the Design and Development Overlay and applying it to the land, introducing a new Schedule 12 to the Development Plan Overlay and applying it to the land and making other consequential changes to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme.
