Works & Road Closures

2014 Tour of the South West

The Anchor Point Tour of the South West will be held in Moynes Shire today (Saturday 26 April) and Warrnambool tomorrow (Sunday 27 April).

To ensure the safety of participants, spectators and the public, the following temporary road closures will apply:

Saturday 26 April (see times below)

- Wangoom Road from St Mary's Road intersection along Wangoom Warrumyea Road to O'Sullivan's Road intersection closed 5am – 6pm.
- St Mary's Road between Wangoom Road and Warne Road closed 6am – 1pm.
- Warne Road closed 6am – 1pm.
- O'Sullivan's Road (south of Wangoom Warrumyea Road) closed 6am – 6pm.
- Hopkins Falls Road between O'Sullivan's Road and Wangoom Road closed 1pm – 6pm.

Sunday 27 April (between 6am – 6pm)

- Bostock Street between the railway bridge and Simpson Street.
- Simpson Street between Ferguson Street and Otway Road.
- Otway Road between Simpson Street and Gladstone Street.
- Gladstone Street between Otway Road and railway bridge.

Spectator parking is available at the Wangoom Uniting Church, Hughes Road Wangoom (via Hopkins Hwy). No vehicle movement will be permitted along the closed sections of roads except in emergency situations.

76 Fairy Street

(Construction of Off Street Car Park)

Works: Pavement and sealing works.

Duration: 4 weeks.

Impact: Parts of the roadway may be closed.

Baileyana Drive

(between McKiernan Road and Collina Court)

McKiernan Road

(between Dales Road and Baileyana Drive)

Works: Road rehabilitation.

Duration: 1 week.

Impact: Motorists and pedestrians to observe signage.

Harris Street Reserve

Works: Lighting upgrade.

Duration: 1 week.

Impact: Minor impact.

Moore Street

Works: Footpath construction.

Duration: 1 week.

Impact: Minor impact to traffic conditions.

Mortlake Road

(north of Moore Street roundabout)

Works: Installation of additional culverts underneath the road and alterations to footpath.

Duration: 7 weeks.

Impact: Road will be open to traffic under speed restriction and traffic control. Footpath under Mortlake Road will be closed from 17 March – 30 May. Traffic controllers will assist school children in crossing Mortlake Road at the Breton Street intersection until the footpath is open for use.
