Warrnambool Planning Scheme

Notice of Approval of Amendment:  
Amendment C76

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C76 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme. The Amendment came into operation on 19 June 2014, as published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment facilitates the residential development of the Coastal Hopkins River Environmental Structure Plan area (north of Hopkins Point Road) by rezoning land to the General Residential Zone, applying Schedule 17 to the Design and Development Overlay to the land, introducing a new Schedule 13 to the Development Plan Overlay and applying it to the land and making other consequential changes to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme.

### Great South Coast Street Smart Lighting Project

Stage 1 of Warrnambool City Councils street lighting installations as part of the Great South Coast Street Lighting Project have commenced. Councils 2,200 residential mercury vapour streetlights will be replaced with new energy efficient LED lights. These new lights will cut energy usage by 77% compared to the existing 80 watt mercury vapour lamps and will considerably reduce running costs. The first stage involves 1068 lights being upgraded to LED fittings and is planned to be completed by 18 July. Visit Council's website for further information.
