Developments Within The West Warrnambool Industrial Precinct

Proposed Milk Processing Facility (Warrnambool Planning Scheme Amendment C94 and Planning Permit Application No. PP2014-0106)

The proposed milk processing facility is located on former Crown land recently purchased by Midfield (part of 10 Scott Street, Warrnambool). This site was previously part of the Council depot and is zoned Public Use Zone (PUZ6 - Local Government). The site is next to the existing Midfield abattoir in Scott Street.

The Midfield Group has requested that the site be rezoned to Industrial 1 Zone in recognition of its private ownership and intended use. The Midfield Group has also lodged a planning application for the use and development of a milk processing facility and reduction of the standard car parking requirements.

Proposed Freezing and Cold Store Facility (Warrnambool Planning Scheme Amendment C96 and Planning Permit Application No. PP2014-0107)

The proposed freezing and cold store facility is located at 19 Scott Street and 26 Strong Street, Warrnambool. The site is currently zoned part Industrial 1 Zone and part Public Use Zone (PUZ6 - Local Government). The site is located opposite the existing Midfield abattoir and next to the Meatbarn retail outlet in Scott Street.

The Midfield Group has requested that the site be rezoned to Industrial 1 Zone in recognition of its private ownership and intended use. The Midfield Group has also lodged a planning application for the use and development of a freezing and cold store facility and reduction of the standard car parking requirements.

Proposed 6 Lot Subdivision (Warrnambool Planning Scheme Amendment C97 and Planning Permit Application No. PP2014-0128)

It is proposed to rezone land at Eccles Street (Lot 2, Eccles Street, Warrnambool), including No 4 & 4A Scott Street, to a Special Use Zone to restrict the development of sensitive uses (i.e. houses) within the buffer to the Midfield abattoir and Fulton Hogan asphalt plant.

The new zone will allow uses (i.e. business (retail and offices), light industry) that are compatible with existing uses within the West Warrnambool Industrial Precinct and nearby residential uses.

An application to subdivide the land at Lot 2 Eccles Street into six (6) lots has also been lodged.
