Expressions of Interest for Hangar/Aviation Park Sites at Warrnambool Regional Airport

Warrnambool City Council has commenced the \$4.9 million Warrnambool Regional Airport Development Project. This much anticipated upgrade will encourage new aviation-related industries to locate on-site, facilitating private investment and helping to drive our region's expanding and diversifying economy. Scheduled for completion in June 2015, key components of the project include:

- Extra taxi-ways, hangar access roads, drainage and essential services to facilitate in excess of 20 additional hangars (subject to configuration) on top of the existing 16 hangars, more than doubling airport hangar capacity.
- Upgrades to the airport's grass runway to facilitate year round aircraft access.

Development is focused around encouraging a variety of aviation activities including general aviation, pilot training, health service flights, charter, aerial agriculture, manufacturing and food export and tourism.
