Works & Road Closures

2014 Fun4Kids Festival

In order to conduct festival operations safely, the following temporary road closures are proposed:

Liebig Street Closure

Location: Smith Avenue to Timor Street.
Closure: Wednesday 11 June, 7am.
Reopening: Thursday 17 July, 5pm.

Timor Street Closure

Location: West of Deakin on Timor car park entrance to Banyan Street roundabout.
Closure: Sunday 15 June, 3 hours only & Sunday 13 July, 3 hours only.

As result of changed traffic conditions and increased traffic from festival patrons the following changes in parking and traffic conditions are proposed:

Liebig Street: Smith Avenue to Merri Street

Construction period: Wednesday 11 June – Saturday 28 July.
Pack up period: Monday 7 July – Thursday 17 July.

- 6 x parking bays designated 30mins short term parking.
- 2 x parking bays designated 30mins Fun4Kids loading bays.
- 3 x parking bays designated 30mins disabled parking.

Festival period: Sunday 29 June – Sunday 6 July.

- 2 x parking bays designated 30mins Fun4Kids loading bays.
- 3 x parking bays designated 30mins disabled parking.
- All remaining parking bays designated 30mins short term parking.

Timor Street: Liebig Street & Banyan Street

Monday 16 June – Thursday 17 July.

- Up to 12 parking bays on the western end of the south side of Timor Street lined with guard rails to prevent vehicles parking against festival marquees.
- Provides a safe pedestrian walkway allowing continued public access.

Sunday 29 June – Sunday 6 July.

- 3 x parking bays close to the festival site will be designated all-day disabled parking.
- 2 x parking bays in front of Maxwell's Bakery to be designated 15min zones.

Timor Street Speed Zone: Banyan Street to Gilles Street

Wednesday 11 June – Thursday 17 July.

- Lower speed limit from 50kph to 40kph.

Art Gallery Car Park Closure

Southern end: 6am Saturday 14 June – 5pm Thursday 17 July.
Northern end: 6am Wednesday 18 June – 5pm Wednesday 9 July.

Lighthouse Theatre Loading Zone

Drop off/pick up zone for the Fun4Kids shuttle bus service and use by emergency vehicles.

76 Fairy Street

(Construction of Off-Street Car Park)
Works: Pavement and sealing works.
Duration: 1 week.
Impact: Parts of the roadway may be closed.

Breakwater Lighting Upgrade

Works: Lighting Upgrade.
Duration: 2 weeks.
Impact: Minimal impact to road users and pedestrians.

Cannon Hill

Works: Tree works.
Duration: 2 weeks.
Impact: Minor disruption to vehicles, pedestrians and car parking.

Dickson Street (east of Watson Street)

Works: Pavement and sealing works.
Duration: 3 weeks.
Impact: Parts of the roadway may be closed.

Hopetoun Road & Crawley Street Intersection

Works: Intersection upgrade.
Duration: 3 weeks.
Impact: Parts of the roadway may be closed.

Horne Road

Works: Finish pavement and sealing works.
Duration: 2 weeks.
Impact: Roadway will be closed until 13 June 2014.

Koroit Street

Frontage of Victoria Park and Friendlies Oval
Works: Granitic sand footpath works.
Duration: 1 week.
Impact: Minimal to road users and pedestrians.

Koroit Street Public Toilets

Works: Koroit Street public toilet upgrade.
Duration: 2 weeks.
Impact: A small section of footpath will be cordoned off but will remain open for pedestrian traffic. While the upgrade is taking place, toilets are available in the nearby Target complex or in the Coles car park.

Mortlake Road

(north of Moore Street roundabout)
Works: Installation of additional culverts underneath the road and alterations to footpath.
Duration: 2 weeks.
Impact: Road will be open to traffic under speed restriction and traffic control. Footpath under Mortlake Road will be closed until 20 June. Traffic controllers will assist school children in crossing Mortlake Road at the Breton Street intersection until the footpath is open for use.

Pickering Point

Works: Stairs upgrade.
Duration: 3 weeks.
Impact: Stairway will be closed.
