Works & Road Closures

Dales Road

Works: Drainage works and roundabout construction at intersection with Gateway Road.

Duration: Works completed by end November 2014.

Impact: Parts of the roadway may be closed to traffic, expect some delays.

Works: Alterations to parking bays for building development.

Duration: 5 weeks.

Impact: Parking bays unavailable and pedestrians will be required to use a temporary footpath.

Payne Reserve Toilet Facility, Dennington

Works: Refurbishment of public toilet.

Duration: Approx. 8 weeks.

Impact: Public toilet will be closed. Closest public toilet will be at the Dennington Recreation Reserve with 24 hour access.

Pickering Point

Works: Stairs upgrade.

Duration: 1 week.

Impact: Stairway will be closed.

Rooneys Road & Raglan Parade Intersection

Works: Installation of stormwater drainage pipes and associated works.

Duration: 4 weeks.

Impact: Road will be open under traffic control. A full road closure will be required from 18 – 22 August. Detours will be in place.

Swan Reserve Play Space Stage 2 (Raglan Parade)

Works: Upgrade the existing Swan Reserve play space adjacent to the kindergarten.

Duration: Works completed by end November 2014.

Impact: Minimal disruption to pedestrian movement.

Trimming of Vegetation from Power line Conductors

Under the Code of Practice for Electric Line Clearance Council must maintain vegetation clearance around power lines in compliance with the Electricity Safety (Electric Line Clearance) Regulations 2010. Council is hereby giving notice that trimming of vegetation on public land within the declared area of the City will be conducted over the next 60 days in order to maintain the required clearance space around power lines prescribed by the Code. New Flood Controls

Warrnambool Planning Scheme Amendment C78

Amendment C78 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme is currently on public exhibition. The amendment applies to land within the Merri River and Russells Creek floodplains as identified as being liable to flooding and inundation during a severe storm of 1 in 100 year intensity.

The amendment proposes to implement the recommendations of the *North Warrnambool Flood Study (2010)*, the *South Warrnambool Flood Study (2007)* and the *Dennington Flood Study (2007)*.
