### Heritage Controls

#### Warrnambool Planning Scheme Amendment C73

Amendment C73 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme is currently on public exhibition.

The amendment proposes to introduce heritage controls to 53 places and proposes to remove heritage controls from the Hopkins River Bridge and 94 Merri Street, Warrnambool, which have recently been removed from the Victorian Heritage Register. The amendment also proposes to correct a number of errors and anomalies within the existing Heritage Overlay.

The amendment will implement the recommendations of the *Warrnambool Heritage Gap Study Stage 3B: Individual Places of Significance, 2010*.
