Warrnambool Planning Scheme

Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment C97

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C97 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme. The Amendment came into operation on 10 September 2015, as published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment:

- Modifies Clause 21.06 (Environment) to include new policy requirements for air quality;
- Inserts a new Schedule 3 to Clause 37.01 (Special Use Zone 3 – Warrnambool West Industrial Precinct – Transition Area) into the scheme; and
- Rezones land at Lot 2 PS702614 Eccles Street, Warrnambool, and 4 and 4A Scott Street, Warrnambool, from General Residential Zone 1 to Special Use Zone Schedule 3.
