Notice of Approval of Amendment
Amendment C73 (Part 1)

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C73 (Part 1) to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment modifies the schedule to Clause 43.01 and corresponding maps to apply the Heritage Overlay to 50 new places, remove the Heritage Overlay from two places and make corrections to various errors and anomalies in the recording of heritage places. The Amendment also lists the 'Warrnambool Heritage Gap Study Statements of Significance 2009' as a reference document at Clause 21.10 and updates the schedule to Clause 61.03.

Warrnambool City Council is inviting public comment on the proposal to give Point Ritchie the dual name: Point Ritchie / Moyjil.

The name Moyjil has been identified as the Indigenous name for this area and provides recognition of its Indigenous values. The significant Aboriginal heritage of the 1.4ha site has already been recognised through a Victorian Government Ongoing Protection Declaration.

The proposed dual name, Point Ritchie / Moyjil, will help provide a more public acknowledgement and celebration of the site's heritage.
