Temporary Road Closures

Tour of the South West

The Anchor Point Tour of the South West will be held in Moyness Shire on Saturday 2 May and Warrnambool Sunday 3 May.

To ensure the safety of participants, spectators and the public, the following temporary road closures will apply.

Saturday 2nd May (see times below)

- Wangoom Road from St Mary's Road Intersection along Wangoom Warrumyea Road to O'Sullivan's Road intersection closed between 5am-6pm.
- St Mary's Road between Wangoom Road and Warne Road closed 11am - 6pm.
- Warne Road closed 11am - 6pm.
- O'Sullivan's Road (South of Wangoom Warrumyea Road) closed 6am - 6pm.
- Hopkins Falls Road between O'Sullivan's Road and Wangoom Road closed 6am - 11pm.

Sunday 3rd May - 6:00am to 6:00pm

- Bostock Street between the railway bridge and Simpson Street
- Simpson Street between Bostock Street and Otway Road
- Otway Road between Simpson Street and Gladstone Street
- Gladstone Street between Otway Road and railway bridge

Please note: Spectator parking available at the Wangoom Uniting Church, Hughes Road Wangoom (via Hopkins Hwy).

Impact: No vehicle movement will be permitted along the closed sections of roads except in emergency situations.
