## Notice of intention to lease

In accordance with Section 190 of the Local Government Act 1989 the Warrnambool City Council gives notice of its intention to enter into a lease agreement with the Warrnambool Sub-Branch of the Returned Services League for 1A Artillery Crescent Warrnambool being part of the land described in Certificate of Title Volume 3044 Folio 608715 excluding any area reserved to the landlord.

The proposed lease is for a fifty (50) year period and will renew an existing lease arrangement.

The proposed purpose of the lease is for the Clubrooms of the Sub Branch and other associated services provided by the tenant which are subject to the written consent of the landlord.

## Public submissions
