Warrnambool Planning Scheme Amendment C98 1-5 and 7-13 Merrivale Drive, Warrnambool

Amendment C98 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme is currently on public exhibition.

The amendment proposes to rezone land at 1-5 and 7-13 Merrivale Drive (corner of Merrivale Drive and Wellington Street) from Industrial 3 Zone (IN3Z) to General Residential Zone 1 (GRZ1). In recognition of the site's former industrial use, the amendment also proposes to introduce the Environmental Audit Overlay (EAO) to the land.
