Planning and Environment Act 1987 WARRNAMBOOL PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment C73 (Part 2)

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C73 (Part 2) to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme.

The Amendment came into operation on the 24 September 2015, as published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment modifies the schedule to Clause 43.01 and accompanying maps to apply the Heritage Overlay to land at 60 Jukes Street and 16 King Street, Warrnambool.
