Notice of the Preparation of an Amendment Amendment C93

The Warrnambool City Council has prepared Amendment C93 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme.

The land affected by the Amendment is all land in the municipality.

The Amendment proposes to implement Stage 1 of the Warrnambool Planning Scheme Rewrite Project. The Warrnambool Planning Scheme Rewrite Project was adopted by Council in February 2015, and meets Council's obligations under Section 12B of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987**. Amongst other changes, the amendment revises the Local Planning Policy Framework of the Warrnambool Planning Scheme, and includes a rewrite of the Municipal Strategic Statement (MSS).

You may inspect the Amendment, any documents that support the Amendment and the Explanatory Report about the Amendment, free of charge, at the following locations:

- during office hours, at the office of the planning authority, Warrnambool City Council, Civic Centre, 25 Liebig Street, Warrnambool.

- at the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning website www.delwp.vic.gov.au/public-inspection.

Any person who may be affected by the Amendment may make a submission to the planning authority about the amendment. Submissions must be made in writing giving the submitter's name and contact address, clearly stating the grounds on which the Amendment is supported or opposed and indicating what changes (if any) the submitter wishes to make. Name and contact details of submitters are required for Council to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend Council meetings and any public hearing held to consider submissions. **The closing date for submissions is Friday, 18 December 2015.**

The planning authority must make a copy of every submission available at its office for any person to inspect free of charge until the end of two months after the amendment comes into operation or lapses.
