Midfield Protein Recovery Processing Plant

A planning permit application (PP2018-0109 which amends 110/99) and a works approval application (1003168) for the proposed protein recovery plant at 24 Scott Street, WARRNAMBOOL 3280 is currently on public exhibition. Notice of the two applications is and will be given jointly, under the provisions of Section 20AA of the Environment Protection Act 1970. The land affected by the applications is in an Industrial Zone.

The proposal is to construct and operate a protein recovery plant with two processing lines and a daily processing rate of 400 tonnes.

The responsible authority will not decide on the application before 17 September 2018 which is at least 14 days after the date of the last notice under section 52(1) or 52(1AA) of the Act is to be given]. If you object, the responsible authority will inform you of its decision.
