Allansford Bridge (Ziegler Parade) Closure for Pipework Investigation

As part of an ongoing commitment to maintain secure and reliable water supplies for Allansford, Koroit and Warrnambool customers, Wannon Water will undertake a preliminary investigation on the North Otway Raw Water Pipeline at the Allansford Bridge section along Ziegler Parade on 16th April 2018.

Contractor RSP Environmental Services has been engaged to excavate the buried pipe at both ends of the bridge.

The work will require the closure of Allansford Bridge for approximately 4 to 5 days. During the closure of the bridge, all vehicles exiting Allansford to Princes Highway will need use Garabaldi Lane or Grauers Road.

No interruptions to water services are planned during the work. Wannon Water apologises for any inconvenience, and thanks the public for their patience during the work.
