Planning and Environment Act 1987 WARRNAMBOOL PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment C102

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment C102 to the Warrnambool Planning Scheme. The Amendment came into operation on the 22 March 2018, as published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment rezones land at 678-688 Raglan Parade, Warrnambool, from a Public Use Zone 1 to a Mixed Use Zone and applies the Environmental Audit Overlay to the land.

Allansford Bridge (Ziegler Parade) Closure For Pipework Investigation

As part of an ongoing commitment to maintain secure and reliable water supplies for Allansford, Koroit and Warrnambool customers, Wannon Water will undertake a preliminary investigation on the North Otway Raw Water Pipeline at the Allansford Bridge section along Ziegler Parade on 16th April 2018.

Contractor RSP Environmental Services has been engaged to excavate the buried pipe at both ends of the bridge. The work will require the closure of Allansford Bridge for approximately 4 to 5 days. During the closure of the bridge, all vehicles exiting Allansford to Princes Highway will need use Garabaldi Lane or Grauers Road.

No interruptions to water services are planned during the work. Wannon Water apologises for any inconvenience, and thanks the public for their patience during the work.
