The Community Development Fund provides funding to eligible organisations that provide opportunities in the areas of sport & recreation, health & wellbeing, culture & arts, festivals & events, and environment & sustainability for the provision of programs, projects, activities or events that deliver outcomes for the benefit of Warrnambool residents.

Funding is available for community-based projects or activities that:

- Deliver new participation opportunities for local residents.
- Increase the range and/ or access to participation opportunities available.
- Deliver agreed environmental or sustainability benefits.
- Promote visitation and tourism and/or increase economic and social opportunities.
- Address a community need which has been identified in an endorsed Council strategy or plan.
