The Amendment proposes to set the policy direction for the Eastern Activity Centre by making changes to the Local Planning Policy Framework, which includes setting a vision and implementation strategies for the area.

Other changes to the Planning Scheme include a Design and Development Overlay which is proposed to be applied to existing commercial areas to guide the design and built form of new commercial and office development.

A Development Plan Overlay is also proposed to be applied to residential land on the south side of Raglan Parade (71 and 83 Raglan Parade, Warrnambool) to provide guidance on future subdivision and development outcomes for the land.
