When: Sunday 24th February, 12-2pm.

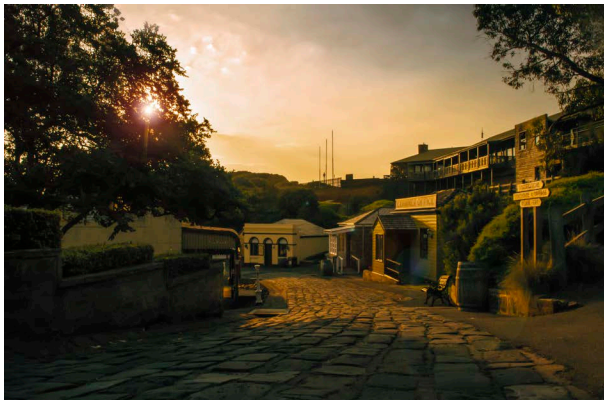
