NOTICE OF BOATING ACTIVITY EXCLUSION ZONE

Warrnambool City Council as the declared waterway manager for Hopkins River between the seaward outlet and Tooram Stones hereby gives notice under section 208(2) of the Marine Safety Act 2010 (Vic) that all persons and vessels not registered to take part in the 2019 South West Regatta are prohibited from entering and remaining in the following waters.

Waters of Hopkins River – Between Hopkins River Bridge (South) and Bostock Street (North).

The exclusion zone will be in effect from 9:00am to 5:00pm on Saturday 2 March and Sunday 3 March 2019.
