The Act also states that: failure to register an animal has a penalty of \$322.

The Community Development Fund provides funding to eligible organisations that provide opportunities in the areas of sport and recreation, health and wellbeing, culture and arts, festivals and events, and environment and sustainability for the provision of programs, projects, activities or events that deliver outcomes for the benefit of Warrnambool residents.

Funding is available for community-based projects or activities that:

- Deliver new participation opportunities for local residents.
- Increase the range and/or access to participation opportunities available.
- Deliver agreed environmental or sustainability benefits.
- Promote visitation and tourism and/or increase economic and social opportunities.
- Address a community need which has been identified in an endorsed Council strategy or plan.

Projects which deliver outcomes which support the endorsed objectives of the Warrnambool 2040 Community Plan, Warrnambool – A Healthy City 2017 – 2021, Green Warrnambool 2018, or the Warrnambool Event Strategy 2018 – 2022 will be strongly supported.
