**Under the Domestic Animals Act pets must be registered with your Council.** The fine for having an unregistered animal is set by the Victorian Government. The fine is currently \$330, up from \$322 last year. In Warrnambool there are one to two dog attacks per month and registration is essential for following up these incidents.

### Have Your Say On Recycling

**Warrnambool City Council is looking at ways to reduce the potential for recyclable materials to end up in landfill.**

As part of the process, Council wants the community to provide feedback on recycling options. Combining paper, cardboard, plastics and glass in one bin creates a contaminated mix of materials that means some of the material is ending up in landfill.

To address this, among the options under consideration is a fourth bin for glass, removing glass, in particular smashed glass, from plastics and paper also means that these materials are more likely to be recycled.

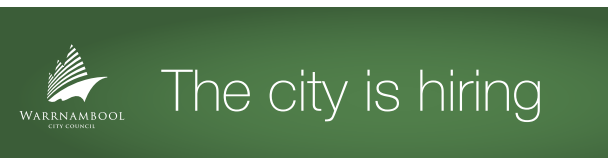
