## Get Involved

### Have your say on Council rates and services

Warrnambool residents are being encouraged to have their say on Council rates and services.

Council has opened an online survey which asks residents to evaluate Council services and whether funding shortfalls should be covered through a rate increase, increased user fees or whether they would prefer to see services cut.

The survey asks people to think about the value they place on Council services, everything from building roads and footpaths to care for the elderly and frail.

A print version of the survey is available from the Civic Centre, 25 Liebig Street, Warrnambool.

### The survey will remain open until February 9.

Following the survey Council will host a workshop, to be held on February 23, at which a panel of up to 60 community members will consider the findings from the survey.

The panel will be assembled through an expression of interest process.

Council will use the findings from this consultation to inform a decision on whether to apply to the Essential Services Commission for a variation to the rate cap, recently announced at 2.5 per cent by the Minister for Local Government Adem Somyurek.
